#### Website Committee Report - Wayne G.

At approximately 6:00 AM 6/14/10 an attacker injected code into Hagerstown Intergroup website. The attack code redirected a user's browser to a site which was designed to trick the user into believing their machine was infected with viruses. The purpose was to get the user to download malicious code. The attacker probably exploited the older version of software that the site was using. At approximately 6:00 PM 6/14/10 Adam G. Reported to Wayne G. That the answering service had reported the compromise. Actions taken: (1) Removed website files (6/14/10); (2) Changed all passwords (6/14/10); (3) Posted minimal page with Intergroup name, a link to a Where and When PDF, and a link to the June newsletter (6/14/10); (4) 6/24 posted new website using new version of content management software; (5) 6/24-6/27 re-posted previous content.
