We are very excited to announce that Mountain Manor Treatment Center/New Horizon/Safe Harbor will be opening back up for 12 step meetings effective March 15, 2021. Group contact persons will be notified individually, and we encourage you to attend and participate with your home group. If you are unable to make it, please contact the treatment center and let us know. A little bit of notice goes a long way. Even an hour's notice gives the counselors on duty an opportunity to plan an alternative activity.

COVID 19 Protocols for Bringing in Outside Speakers

First, we would just like to thank the speakers for your continued willingness to serve and to carry the message of Alcoholics Anonymous to this treatment facility. We are asking that you send no more than four speakers for the time being in order to observe social distancing requirements. We are asking speakers to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of the meeting and to go directly to the security shed so that a nurse can come and take temperatures and go through COVID 19 protocol questions. We are asking that speakers wear a mask at all times while at the facility with the exception of when you are speaking. We are asking that speakers maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet from patients at all times. Please no hugging or handshaking until further notice. Together we can make this safe for everyone and again we would like to thank you for your willingness to share your time and resources and continue to share a message of hope. Report from The NERAASA 2021 Completed Roundtable

Hello, my name is Kathi and I'm an alcoholic. I am the Area 29 Intergroup Liaison Chair for Maryland's 10 Intergroups and I was the Recorder for the Central and Intergroup Office Roundtable. Our moderator was Sean C., Chairperson for Area 13. We had 21 participants on Friday and 29 on Saturday, with tech support from Deanna in Area 11 and interpretation by Rosa. 11 Areas were represented.

Our group consisted of 2 paid office administrators, intergroup chairs, vice chairs, and volunteers, 3 intergroup Reps/liaisons/delegates, 3 intergroup treasurers, and members from the Area 13 Hispanic Intergroup and the Area 44 Polish Intergroup. We also had one *District* whose Area solely relies on district volunteers for managing all of their Twelfth Step calls.

On AA in a Time of Change, Intergroups are navigating the front line as usual but with added pandemic work and less volunteers. A few of our hot topics included:

1. Keeping up with evolving meeting lists and developing lists that are searchable. This level will not decrease when the pandemic is over since virtual meetings are here to stay.
2. Finding avenues of communication with groups for meeting changes and updating the website. Most are using various email platforms and find it beneficial to require these changes in writing.
3. Part time workers have seen increases in their workloads because the volunteer foot traffic is down. Offices rely on volunteers to answer the phones which allows the special workers to focus on their paid assignments. We need effective remote phone systems and volunteers to help field the calls.
4. Answering services are always an ongoing topic, everyone uses something different. We explored a new reasonably priced vendor for phone services and potential email support, this has been researched by the Vancouver Intergroup with good results.
5. At least two Intergroups collaborate in joint committees that overlap Area and Intergroup. Intergroups find that more awareness or education is needed as many members are not clear on the separate functions of each entity.
6. We also have many groups struggling to establish a new Intergroup in many desert pockets. The ICOAA Seminar was mentioned as an avenue for support in their shared purpose. They know well that most intergroups don't have enough resources and look for ways to do more with less by working together.
