AA SPONSORS NEEDED FOR MOUNTAIN MANOR PATIENTS

The long-term programs at Mountain Manor, (New Horizon males and females and Safe Harbor females) will soon begin attending outside meetings with an eligible sponsor.

To be eligible to serve as a sponsor, you must meet the following requirements:

- Must have 2 years of sobriety
- Must have a sponsor and be active in the AA fellowship
- Must provide a COVID vaccination card for Mountain Manor to copy. Your name will be whited out
- Male patients may only attend meetings on Tuesdays & Wednesdays, between the hours of 5:30 PM and 9:30 PM with a maximum window of 3 hours total
- Female patients may only attend meetings on Mondays & Fridays, between the hours of 5:30 PM and 9:30 PM with a maximum window of 3 hours total
- Mountain Manor limits sponsorship to only one patient. Travel arrangements to and from meetings are limited to sponsor & patient, no additional people

If interested, contact **Kye Stephenson at 301-447-2360**. Leave your name and telephone number. Patients will be provided with a list of sponsors to select from. Mountain Manor requires that the patient make initial contact with the sponsor.

After initial contact, the new sponsor must call the treatment center, speak to the patient's counselor, and confirm you agree to the sponsorship.
