Any suggested revisions requiring a change to policy will be brought to the intergroup for discussion and vote during the continued review of the bylaws and before a final draft is presented for approval.

The first change was to remove the word "Standing" wherever a committee is mentioned, as this terminology is outdated. Committees at GSO and Area level stopped using this term years ago.

After review of the bylaws, the committee will consider what type of document should be created to maintain the Descriptions and Duties of Committees for the Intergroup's use. The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 15 at 7:00 pm.
